A Season to Share, A Season to Serve

Have you noticed how people light up about the things they're most involved in? Just ask a football dad, a volleyball mom, or your foodie friend who just discovered the perfect recipe. Their excitement spills over, leading them to invite others into what they love.

I've heard it said that "Engagement fuels involvement. Involvement fuels passion. Passion fuels invitation." The pull of our families, the pressure to secure "our" seats, and the distraction of serving while trying to focus on worship can leave us feeling stretched and less present but it also can work against us the opposite way, as our serving can distract our time to really worship our newborn King. At Trinity, we want you to receive the gift of both this season because we want it to be about the transformative love of Jesus. By intentionally choosing to serve during this special time, we demonstrate the heart of the gospel, a Savior who came not to be served, but to serve. And when we serve, we become part of the story, extending an invitation that might just be the beginning of someone's life being changed by Jesus.

Think about the small acts of kindness that have encouraged you here at Trinity? A warm smile, a kind word in the halls, or a nursery volunteer easing your mind. These simple gestures can make all the difference. This Christmas, you can be the one offering them. That's the kind of church we want to be at Trinity: a church that shares Jesus with passion, hospitality, and a servant's heart. This Christmas let's be engaged with our family, friends, and quests in worship "and" in serving. Let's invite others into the joy and hope that comes from knowing Jesus. Together, we can create an environment that truly changes everything, not just for us, but for those God is drawing near.
