Secretary's Report - 1) Thank you from Pastor Ollie and Karen for Pastor Appreciation gift, 2) Raise the Roof Team gave thank-you to Council for gift for the auction. Collection schedule distributed for sign up.

October meeting minutes were approved. October financials were approved. There were no membership adjustments.

Business Administrator reports

HVAC - Glycol tank has been installed, no word on Roof Top units originally scheduled to ship the end of November

Classroom Project - Lights have been delivered, waiting on electrician to install. Drywall got painted. Kaleb working on flooring

Call Committees – Assisting committees as needed

Trunk or Treat - Held indoors in hallways due to inclement weather. Hallways were full and everyone had a great time

Raise the Roof - Assisted with selling tickets, printing auction booklets, ordering supplies, etc.

Receptionist/Volunteer Coordinator vacancy - Michele Bristol started Oct 30th. She's sent a mailing out to see what people's preferences are for communion servers, ushers, etc. Training ongoing as occurred

Rental house for Interim Pastor - All utilities set up. Met Allo at house to install internet. Assisted Welcome Committee in purchasing furniture and collecting items for gift basket

Lead Pastor Call Committee report

The Committee conducted over-the-phone interviews with 2 potential candidates. One candidate was ruled out because is still going to school and is not ordained. His resume will be kept on file for future opportunities. The second candidate will be here on December 6th to meet with Staff and Council for informal questions. If all goes well, candidate will be requested to return in January to preach at a church service

Old Business

Raise the Roof – Held on Sunday, November 5th, at Friedhof Building. Event tickets sold were 165; Net proceeds were over \$40,000; Sold 186 tickets (16 unsold) for 4-wheeler raffle: 120 Silent Auction and 30 live auction items donated. Special thanks to Angie Biester for all her hard work organizing the event

2024 Budget - After a final review of draft #4, motion made to accept, seconded, and carried

Welcome Team - Kay Johnson presented a handout outlining what was done to prepare house prior to Pastor Hall's arrival.

New Business

Approve Pastor Hall's (Doc's) housing allowance request. Motion made. seconded, and carried.

Council Openings - After terms have expired or others chose not to run for reelection, council will have one (1) opening. Council members are to bring names of potential candidates to December meeting

Christmas Offering – Decision will be made at December meeting on how much and where to donate. Council members are to bring ideas for programs

Staff Christmas Bonuses - Council reviewed a list of previous bonuses. Adjustments were made to the list. Motion made to accept new list, seconded, carried

Next Trinity Council Meeting will be held on Tuesday, December 12th, 2023 at 6:30 pm.



"A Small Group Ministry"

Hebrews 10:25, "And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near."

If you've never been part of a church with *Small Groups* we want to invite you to give it a try.

Some *Small Groups* will only meet for 2-3 weeks. Other *Small Groups* might choose to meet weekly or bi-weekly, and other schedules might only allow for them to gather monthly – it's all up to the group.

But for now, we would like to offer you two different but exciting opportunities to join us in becoming a part of a Small Group. The first Group will be a 4-week course entitled: *Discover The Bible*. This course is for all people regardless of how well you know how to use your Bible. This course is intended to be fun and instructive. No need to be intimidated. This course will teach you some simple basics that enable you to navigate through the scriptures in order to help discover answers to your questions.

You can sign up for this class at the *Information Station*. We will gather on Tuesday nights from 6:00 PM to 7:30 PM. Mark your calendars and don't miss out on these four dates: January 23 & 30 and February 6 & 13



The second opportunity is for a 4-week *Adult Confirmation Class*. For most of us, Confirmation was an obligation. This course is designed for all adults. Perhaps you have either transferred into the Lutheran Church as an adult but have never either been confirmed or you have been a Lutheran your whole life and would like to join a refresher course? helped you to better understand your faith. There will also be an opportunity for you to join your class in a *Confirmation* rite that allows for you to publicly confirm your faith.

Small Groups are simply an opportunity for men to gather with other men, or women to gather with other women, to meet each other, maybe to help someone in need, to laugh together, to enjoy each other's company, and to grow in your relationship as brothers and sisters in Christ. 
