

The August 20, 2024. Council meeting was called to order by President Kris Gernstein.

Pastor Billy led a devotional based on Mark 1:14-15.

Secretary Kay Johnson reported three cards of appreciation were received.

The minutes for the July 16, 2024, Council meeting were approved. The financial report ending July 31, 2024, was approved.

Pastoral Reports outlined future sermon series' and Christmas Eve services. Pastor Billy informed the Council that Landon Sliva will be interning at Trinity for two years and the Rite of Confirmation Service will be held the first weekend in May.

Business Administrator Report:

- Phase 1 of the HVAC project will be finalized with the replacement of the thermostats.
- The High School Classroom Project has a new projection system being • installed. Possible repair/replacement of the AC unit to be done in the springtime.
- The **Roof** is being addressed by an insurance adjuster.
- Storage reorganization is being examined for room 11 and the Fellowship • Hall.
- The Global Leadership Conference in Bellevue on August 8 & 9 was well attended by staff and council.

Old Business:

- Sign: a new sign design for Trinity is to be created by Love Signs in Norfolk for next month's Council meeting.
- Ouestions/Coffee Talk recap was given by Pastor Billy. Volunteerism and communication were areas for improvement.
- Pastor Billy's Service of Installation will be held the weekend of Sept. 7 & 8.
- The Council Retreat/Refresh will be held Saturday, Nov. 2. •

New Business:

- Future Staff Positions were reported by Pastor Billy. The open receptionist • position will be filled with the use of volunteers. Two new positions of Volunteer Coordinator and Communications Coordinator are needed. A job description is being developed for a future Youth & Family Pastor position.
- 2025 Budget: A discussion was held of preliminary budget items for 2025 along with designated donations.
