Samaritan's Purse

Samaritan's Purse is an International Christian organization serving during natural disasters throughout the world with field hospitals, food, water and other supplies needed. There is also a Veteran's

program that offers to help heal the soldiers suffering the effects of combat all in

the name of Christ Jesus, "Heal Our Patriots." For the children, there is a program called Operation Christmas Child. These are the shoe boxes Trinity fills up every year! These boxes contain toys, school supplies, clothing and hygiene items. After receiving a box, the children are taught about Jesus and the world that God created. Trinity gives \$250 a month to Samaritan's Purse. At times, a special offering is taken for specific disaster areas that happen. The shoeboxes are a separate way of giving by individuals as we pack boxes once a year. All help and gifts are given in the name of Jesus Christ.



Curious, what season of the year do you enjoy most? For me, nothing is better than the season of fall. Cooler temperatures, fewer bugs, trees changing to reveal beautiful colors, and all my favorite sports happening at the same time (football, volleyball, and playoff baseball). Plus, it means we are getting closer to the holidays. It becomes a season of

reflection and anticipation as another year begins to close. Full disclosure, this time of year with all the good it provides can bring joy, but if I am honest, it can also become overwhelming. Just as quickly as the leaves change colors, we can find ourselves being pulled in many directions, balancing responsibilities, caring for loved ones, and still seeking meaning and purpose amidst the hustle and bustle. Why do we feel this way? Even when faced with many good things, why does life seem to rob us of our joy?

This is a little bit of the "why" behind our current message series, "Ephesians: Growing into the Fullness of God." In this journey, we are exploring how, even when life feels chaotic, we can anchor ourselves in something greater: the love and strength of Christ. There is a pivotal moment in chapter 3 of Ephesians where we read that the Apostle Paul prayed for the church in Ephesus and still prays for us today. A prayer that we might be "filled to the measure of all fullness" and be able to "grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ" (Ephesians 3:17-19). Throughout this series, we're discovering what it means to experience that amazing and big love for ourselves individually, and as a community, as we prepare our hearts for what lies ahead, so that we can enjoy it with open arms rather than bringing a "brace yourself" mentality.

Ultimately, Paul reminds us of a crucial truth: **faith is not about perfection, but about a continual, grace-filled walk with Jesus**. It's okay to struggle or feel like we're not measuring up. Together, we're learning that as we stay connected to Christ and to one another, His grace meets us where we are and helps us grow. Truth is, growth doesn't happen overnight; it's organic, gradual, and happens as we lean into the love of Jesus, especially in the midst of life's busyness.

If you're searching for a deeper sense of peace and purpose as we prepare for the

season ahead, we want to encourage you to read through Ephesians with us over these next weeks. Let this be a time of preparation, not just for the holidays, but for our hearts. Giving us all an opportunity to grow as individuals and as a church family, discovering what it means to live in the fullness of God's love. If you or someone you know is longing for more strength, more peace, and a deeper purpose, feel free to invite others or come yourself to be part of this journey. Let's grow together, one step at a time, in the unforced rhythms of Jesus' grace.



September Council Notes*

The September 17, 2024, Council meeting was called to order by President Kris Gernstein.

Pastor Billy led a devotional based on Matthew 11:28-30.

The minutes for the August 20, 2024, Council meeting were approved.

The financial report ending August 31, 2024, was approved.

Pastoral Reports:

- Pastor Billy thanked Council for the Installation Service; shared some upcoming events: a Worship Support Appreciation Dinner on Oct. 13; Teens Encounter Christ (TEC) weekend Nov. 8-10 here at Trinity; 8-week Starting Point Class beginning Sept. 18
- Pastor Ollie shared he has two weeks of The Creed class remaining and two weddings in October

Business Administrator Report:

- The HVAC project is near finalized as the electrician is schedule the week of Sept. 16 to replace thermostat wire.
- The High School Classroom Project; new projection system was installed and paid for by the Memorial Committee. A bid from Eller Heating & Air for \$3,915.00 was received to replace the air conditioning unit. Replacement isn't planned until spring.
- No word from the insurance adjuster on the **Roof**.
- Storage reorganization/staff cleaning day will be held Sept. 23.
- **REALM Software** conversion timeline to be determined.
- LCMC Conference will be attended by Pastor Ollie, Pastor Billy, Manuel and Tammy Sept. 29-Oct 2.
- Wedding Handbook is being updated.
- Met with some Office Volunteers regarding coverage of the receptionist desk. Response was positive. Still need a few volunteers to fill spots.

Old Business:

- Sign: a new sign design for Trinity was created by Love Signs. After discussion, it was sent back to Love Signs for modifications.
- Missions Board: will be doing a "Mission Impact" update during services once a month as well as an article in Tidings each month.
- Future Staff Positions: Pastor Billy is still working on a job description for a future Youth & Family Pastor position. Currently focusing on two parttime positions being filled.

New Business:

- Christ Lutheran Church (LCMC) Partnership: Christ Lutheran is proposing doing a partnership with Trinity on a third pastor. Pastor Billy and/or Pastor Ollie will talk with Christ Lutheran to discuss their needs.
- October is Pastor Appreciation Month: Pastors Billy and Ollie would rather this be recognized as Pastor and Staff Appreciation Month. A basket will be placed a Grand Central to collect cards in the month of October.
- Future Building Renovations: Approval was given by Council for Pastor Billy to contact two consulting firms regarding building renovations. Pastor has worked with both firms in the past and was very pleased with their process of conducting interactive planning and vision sessions to help determine our vision and then providing a custom plan to make our facility a place for growth.
- Trunk or Treat will be held indoors on Sunday, October 27 from 4-6pm. Next regular Council meeting will be held Tuesday, October 15 at 6:30 p.m.
